## Voluntary Equine Waiver and Release Form



I, the **Participant**, understand that there are risks inherent in dealing with equines and equine activities, such as, but not limited to, the following:

- The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to persons on or around the equine.
- The unpredictability of an equines' reaction to sound, sudden movements, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals.
- That there may be hazards, including, but not limited to, surface and surface conditions.
- The possibility of a collision with another equine, animal, person or object.
- The potential of an equine activity Participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the Participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the Participant.

With full understanding of the inherent risk involved in equine activities, the Participant agrees to waive, release and hold harmless the Hastings Lake Pleasure Horse Association, the Hastings Lake Community Association, its staff, management and any person involved in organizing activities from any loss, damage, injury, accident, illness or disease by any Participant.

## Open Horse Show Rules

- 1) All classes open to sound horses, ponies, donkeys and mules.
- 2) Un-sportsman like behavior, foul language and/or animal abuse will not be tolerated in the arena or on the show grounds. Failure to comply could lead to disqualification from a class or ejection from the entire show at the discretion of the judge, ringmaster and/or show committee.
- 3) Stallions must be handled by persons 18 years or older and must be double tied and at no time left unattended.
- 4) Dress Code: long pants, shirts and boots with heel are mandatory for all classes. No shorts or tank tops, including Gymkhana.
- 5) **Equine helmets** are mandatory for ages under 18 at all times when mounted and strongly recommended for all riders.
- 6) All tack must be safe and serviceably sound.
- 7) The judge's decision is final.
- 8) Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Do not leave dogs unattended at any time. No aggressive dogs allowed.
- 9) In the event of rain or severe weather the show may be postponed or cancelled at the discretion of the show committee.
- 10) Cross entries are not allowed in Halter, Lead Line or Trail Classes
- 11) The gatekeeper must be advised of tack changes prior to class. **TEN MINUTES ONLY** will be allowed for tack changes.
- 12) Martingales and tie downs allowed in gymkhana events only.
- 13) Kickers are to be flagged. Ribbon markers will be provided if necessary
- 14) The show committee reserves the right to postpone, combine, or cancel classes as circumstances dictate.
- 15) In Hand Trail-the handler must be able to independently guide the equine safely.
- 16) Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place.

**Concession** starts with breakfast and will be open throughout the day  
**Lunch break** will be announced and will be approximately one half-hour long.

Water will be available, please bring your own bucket.  
Clean up after yourself and your horse, including hay and manure.
